October 20th, 2020:	"Write-In Candidacy" Filing Period Ends.
October 27th, 2020:	Last Day Election Office mails ballots; Recommended Last Day for Voters to Mail Ballots.
November 3rd, 2020:	Election Day (7AM-8PM); Last Day to Return Ballot In-Person or Last Date Postmarked.
